The Fees set forth in the box above are the base fees for meets involving both Boys and Girls teams. Additional fees may apply in the case of additional heats. A meet that is Boys-only or Girls-only is half the Boys and Girls meet fee. The number of teams has no impact on Fees.

An Extra Fee may be due depending on the number of extra heats in the meet. In a Boys *or* Girls *only* meet, the teams are allowed as many as 5 additional heats for no extra fee. In a Boys and Girls dual meet, the teams are allowed as many as 10 additional heats for no extra fee. For the first five heats above the allowed number of “free” additional heats, the extra fee is \$15 for the referee, \$10 for the starter, and \$5 for S&T. If there are 6 to 10 additional heats above the allowed number of “free” additional heats, the extra fee is \$30, \$20, and \$10, respectively. For 11 to 15 additional heats above the allowed number of “free” additional heats, each official receives an extra single meet fee (\$57.50 for the referee, \$52.50 for starter, and \$47.50 for S&T). For 21 or more additional heats above the allowed number of “free” additional heats, each official receives an extra Boys and Girls meet fee.

In a Boys and Girls meet, every diver above 12 in number is considered an additional heat. In a single-gender meet, every diver above 6 in number is considered an additional heat. The use of an 11-dive format at a boys and girls meet counts as an additional heat.

There is no mileage reimbursement if the round trip is 10 miles or less. For mileage above 10 miles round-trip, mileage is 44 cents for the first 125 miles, and 22 cents per mile after that. Assignors have been instructed to keep mileage costs to the lowest amount reasonably possible when scheduling officials for meets.
